All parties wishing to participate in this hearing must attend in person unless the use of Remote Communication Technology is authorized by this Court in advance of the hearing. This Court follows the Memorandum Regarding Use of Remote Communication Technology by the Trial Courts issued on September 21, 2021, by the South Carolina Supreme Court. Notice of a Virtual Hearing or virtual participation by a witness or party must be given in the same manner to the same persons within the same time as required for an in person hearing unless all interested persons consent to the Virtual Hearing or virtual participation by a witness or party.
