## WHO WE ARE

The team consists of licensed counselors assigned to patrol squads that provide around-the-clock support. An Horry County Police Department Officer and a Licensed Counselor supervise the Crisis Intervention Team.



## HOW WE CAN HELP

The Crisis Intervention Team provides on-site substance abuse and mental health interventions for individuals in need. Crisis Intervention Team counselors coordinate appropriate assessments and referrals, ensuring individuals receive the necessary support. The Crisis Intervention Team also conducts follow-ups to offer continued assistance.



## WHAT WE DO

Crisis Intervention Team counselors respond to calls to help de-escalate mental health emergencies, conduct acute behavioral health screenings, and perform on-site mental health assessments. They work to connect individuals in need with appropriate clinical referrals and additional community resources.
